Please find enclosed the Building Permit, this was an Internal Item from the Building Department to Operations, just thought you may like to have a copy, the fee was just transferred from within the two departments. There are also pictures enclosed, a second set will follow.

The pictures are very interesting, we are so pleased with the Ecodur201S, it is an awesome product and I could tell it was a winner when I first saw it, no doubt we made the correct decision to go with Castagra for the coatings. I was very impressed with Louis Turner, he is so dedicated to Castagra and the product and a real pleasure to work with. I would highly recommend your product and Louis Turner, I will definitely try and obtain contracts for Castagra.

Pittsburgh Tank and Tower also completed the project on time and with the highest level of professionalism. Within the contract it was specified the roof was to receive an application of Ecodur201S, however the weather conditions prevented this from happening. We will still remit full payment to Pittsburgh for the cost of the project, however coming into the spring early summer season, we will need to apply the Ecodur201S with ultraviolet protection to the roof of the structure. We can most likely do this ourselves, utilizing the Hand Kits. I have a small containment dam at the Water Plant and a small roof on a structure I would also like to do, when warmer weather visits Pickle Lake, (May or June). Will you need the size of the containment dam and the small roof, please advise.

The Tower has been filled for one week, all sampling requirements have been addressed, we were able to bring the higher levels of Sodium Hypochlorite into acceptable levels by overflowing the tower, this was a controlled exercise and it did work very well. With the Tower full, everything has performed perfectly to date, the Draft Tube and Recirculation Line are preventing stratification, CL2 Levels are the same at the very top layer and middle layer of the water as at the bottom portion of the tank. The tank was placed in full service, online to the town as of 2:00 pm today.
