

CASTAGRA CERTIFIED APPLICATOR APPLICATION SUMMARY

Steps to become a Castagra Certified Applicator

1. Attend training annually
 - Note: Castagra Certified Applicator status only lasts a year after which applicator must re-attend Castagra training
2. Take and pass quiz with score of 17/21
3. Successfully complete first qualifying project
4. Ensure first project meets Project Qualification Guidelines (see below)
5. Fill out the Certified Applicator Application
6. Provide proof of insurance or employment with a Castagra Licensed Company
7. Send in before/after photos (and during if possible) of first successfully completed project

First Project Qualification Guidelines

- Must involve at least 5 full 50lb kits
 - Ensures that multiple buckets are mixed properly
- Demonstrates ability to:
 - Identify a suitable substrate (clean, dry, tight, nothing brittle)
 - Properly prepare a project
 - > Demonstrate ability to properly clean the substrate, eliminating dirt, oils, or any other contaminants
 - Properly mix product:
 - > Some of the most difficult to fix mistakes are made by improperly mixing Ecodur
 - Properly apply the product
- Ensure proper application tools are being used:
 - Applied with a notched squeegee
 - Correct chip brushes, ¾" nap roller
 - Any other tools as necessary for the specific project
- Provide proof of access to proper inspection tools:
 - RWS or equivalent moisture detector
 - Core cutter
 - Seam checker
- Other requirements may be added, at any time and without notice, if a need arises.

Additional Notes:

- Castagra Certified Applicator status can be withdrawn by Castagra for any reason, including but not limited to applicator failure to meet Castagra quality standards, misrepresentation of Castagra products, failure to follow through with applicator responsibilities, etc.
- Castagra Certified Applicators are required to perform all work on warranty projects
- Castagra Certified Applicators can independently offer Premier Materials Warranties
- NDL applications require Castagra Licensed Companies
